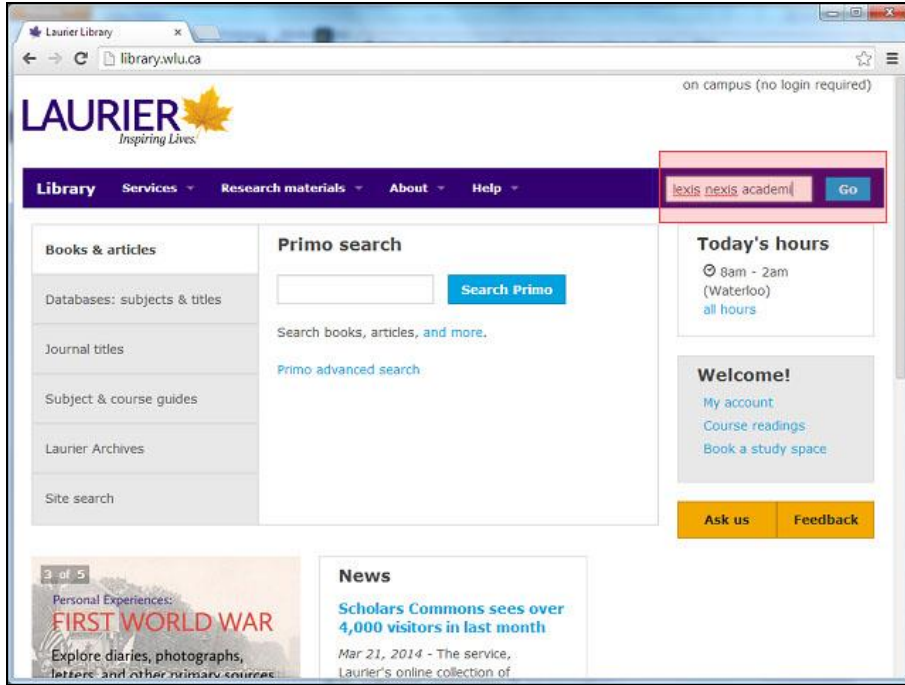

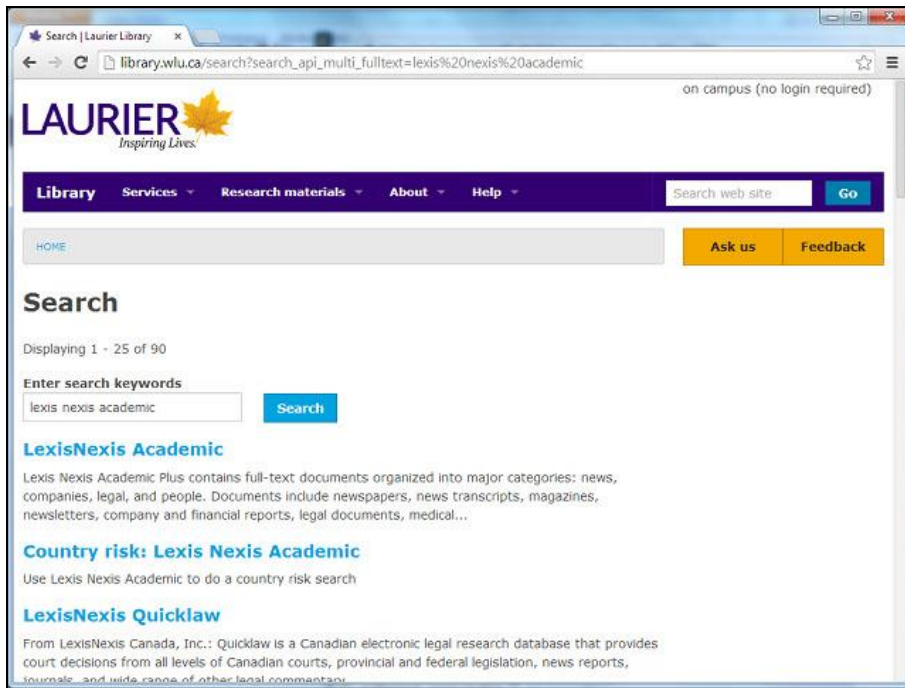
- use Lexis Nexis Academic to find country risk analysis

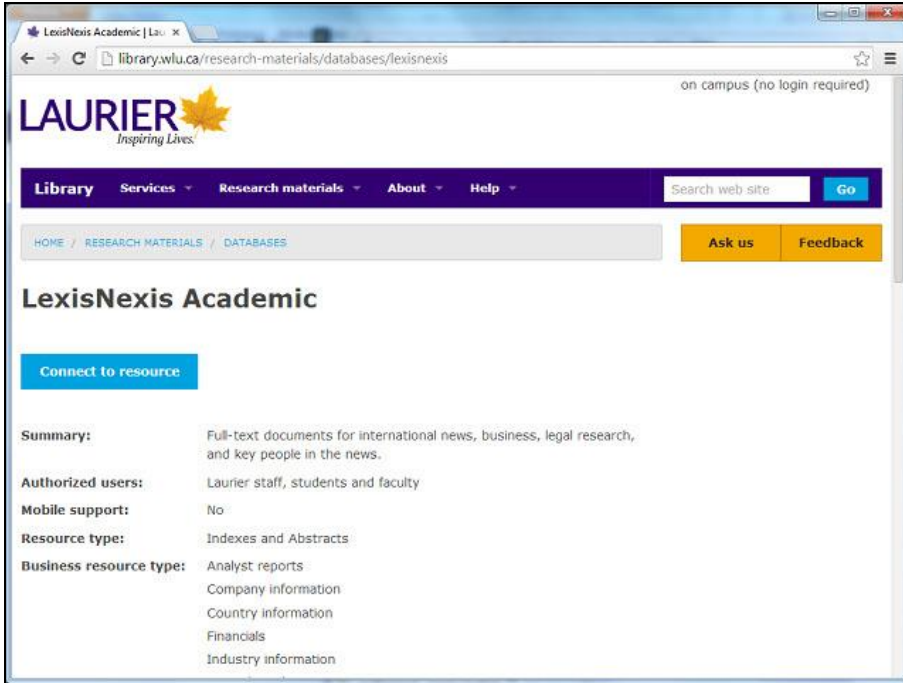


To find it, type Lexis Nexis Academic in the Search Web Site box in the menu bar of the Library web site, then press Go.

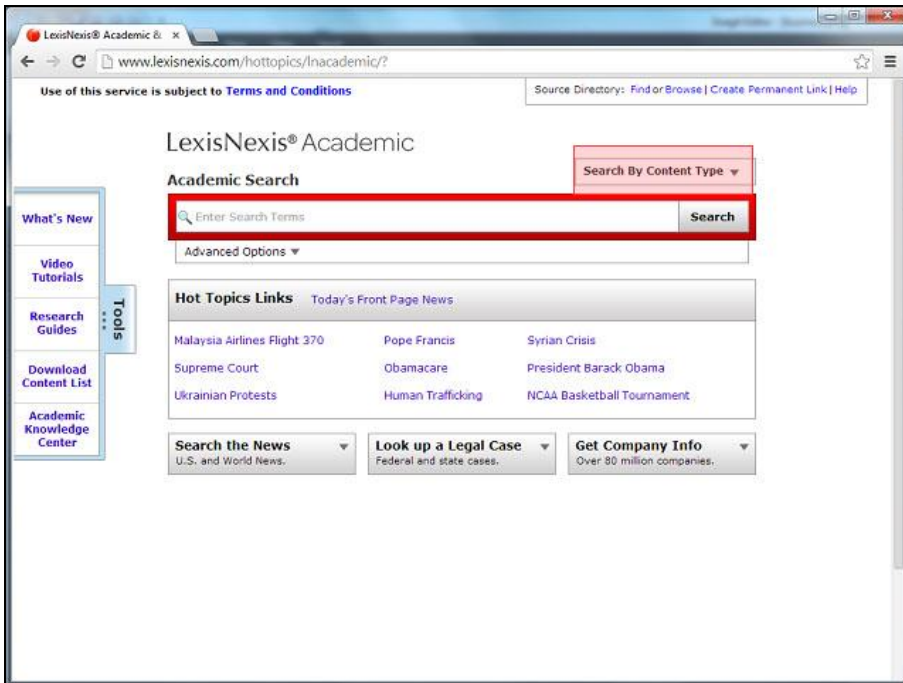


Click on the database title.

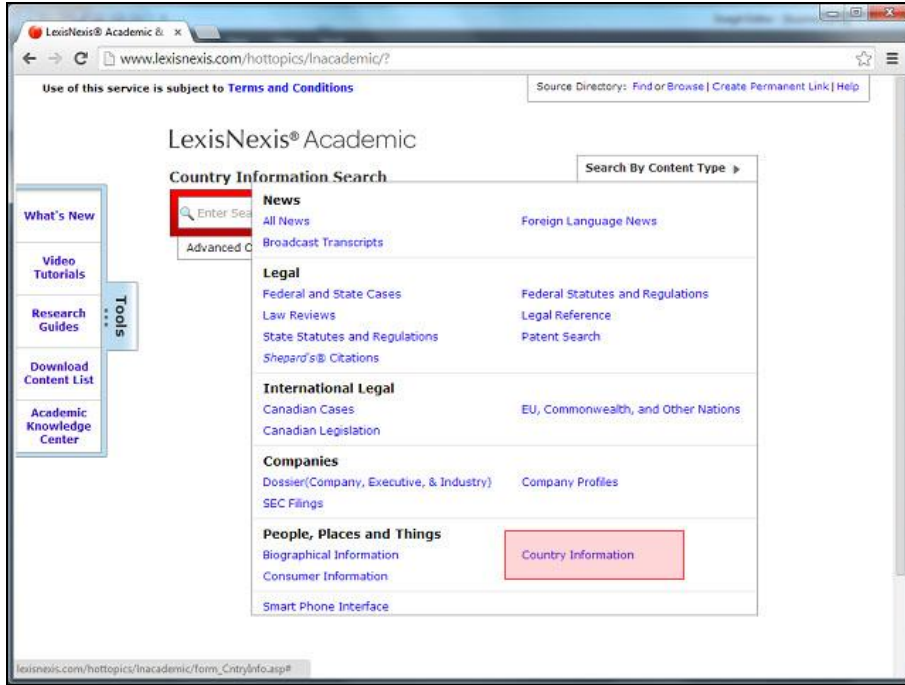


Then click on Connect to Resource.

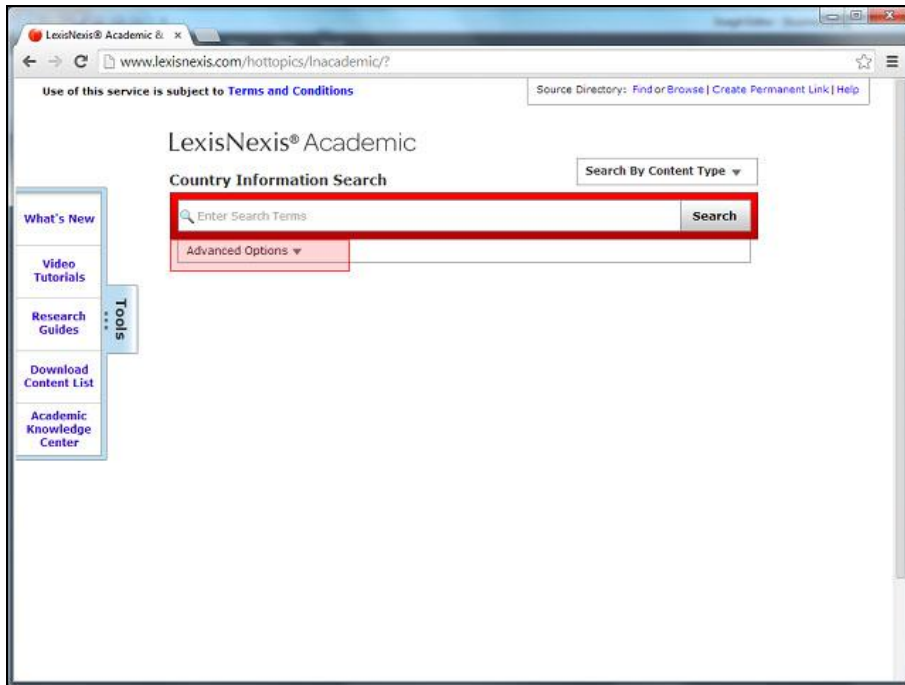


To find country risk, you'll first need to click on Search by Content Type above the search box.

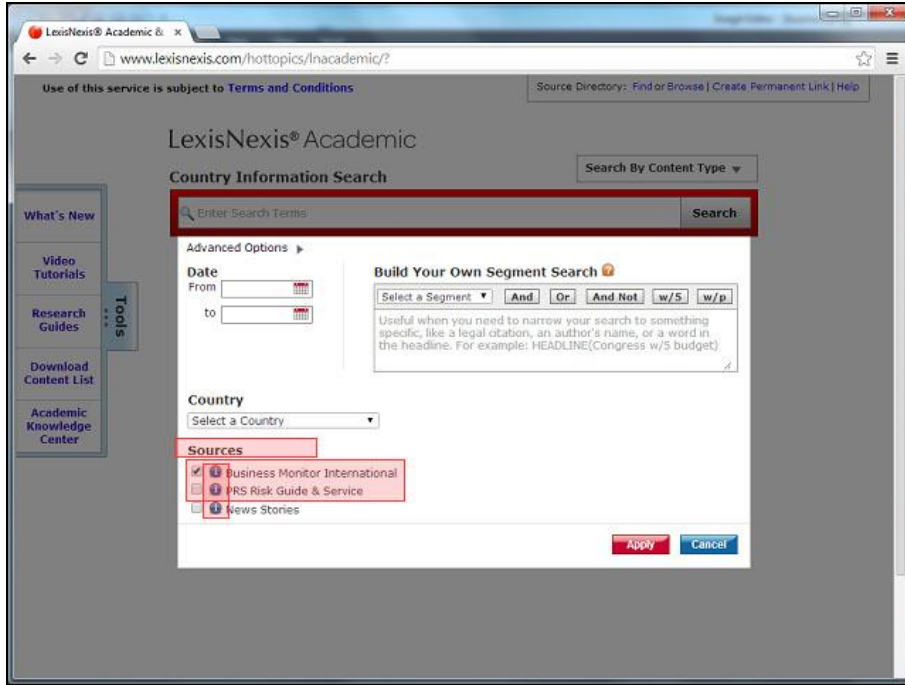


Pick Country Information from the list of content types.



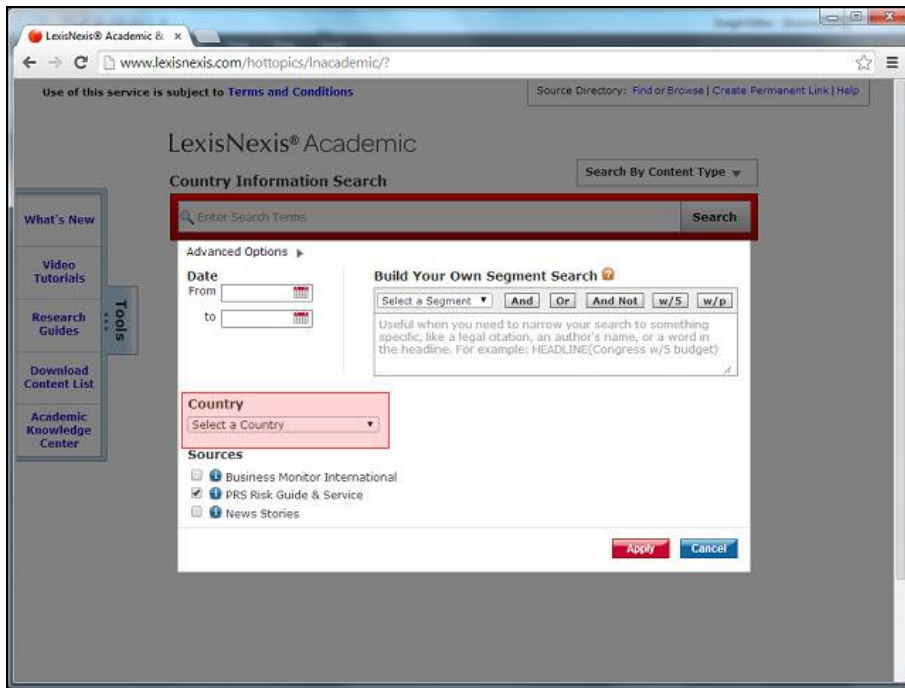
Now you'll need to specify what you want to search for.
To do this, click on Advanced Options under the search box.

You'll need to enter your search options here.

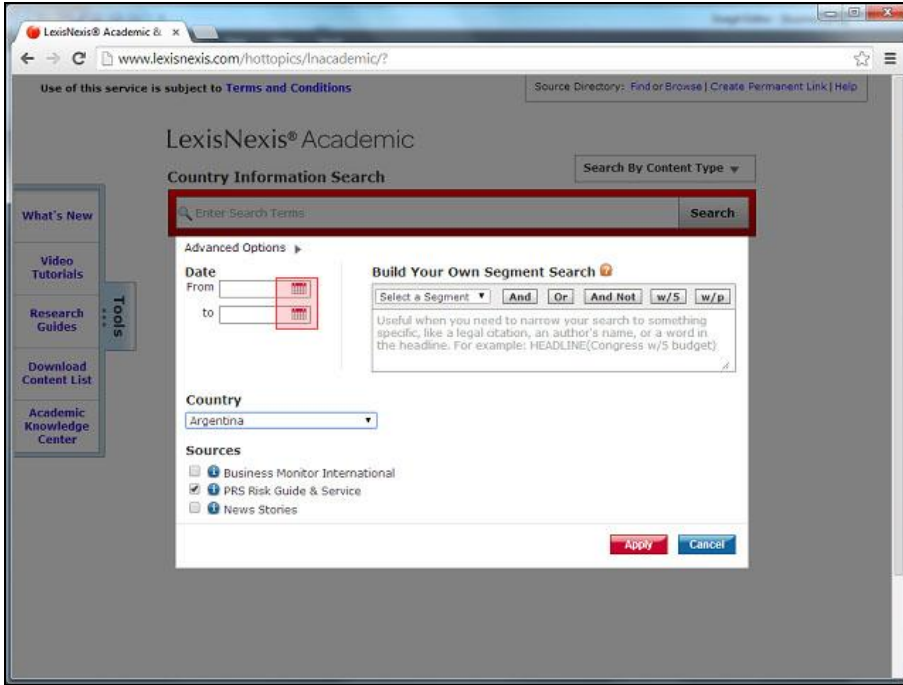
Under Sources, uncheck Business Monitor International and check PRS Risk Guide and Service. If you want more information about any of these, you can click on the More Information icon next to them.



Then choose a country to search for from the drop-down list under Country.

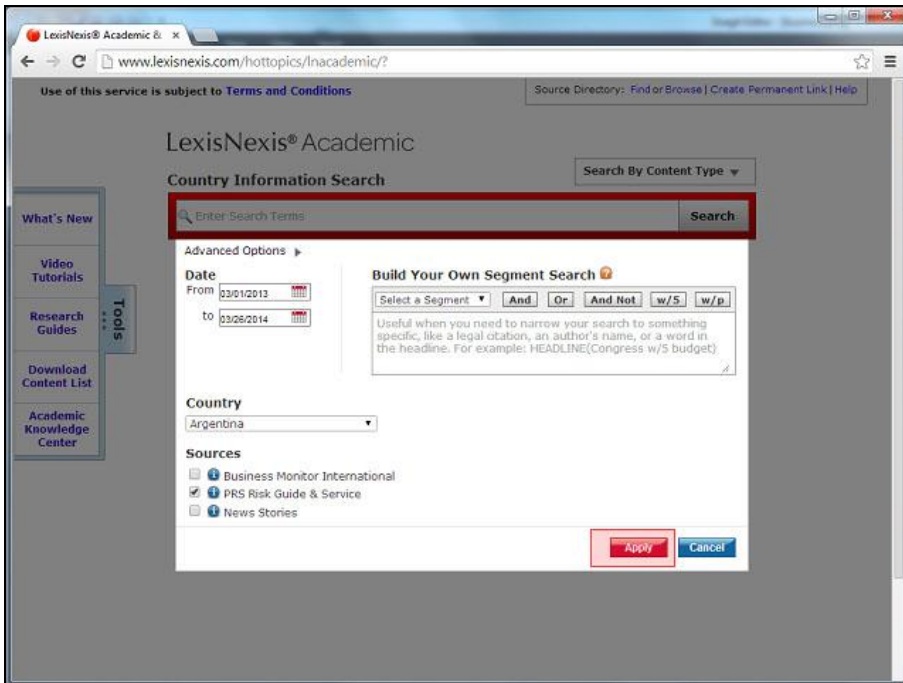
We'll choose Argentina.

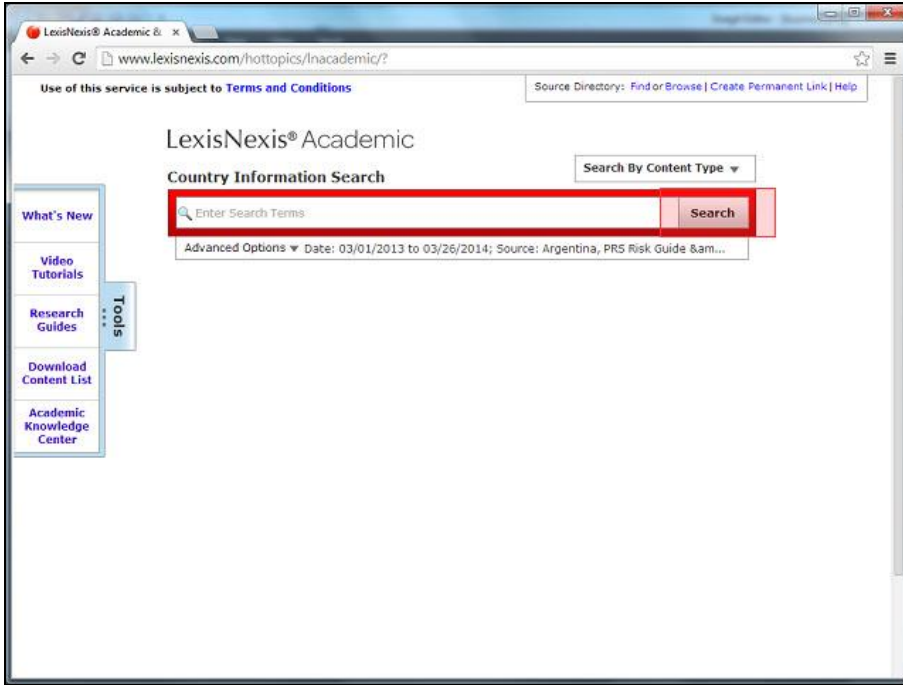
Finally we need to specify the date range we want to search for.

Click on the calendar icons to choose a to and from date. We'll select the last year.



Once you've selected your dates, you're ready to go. Click Apply.

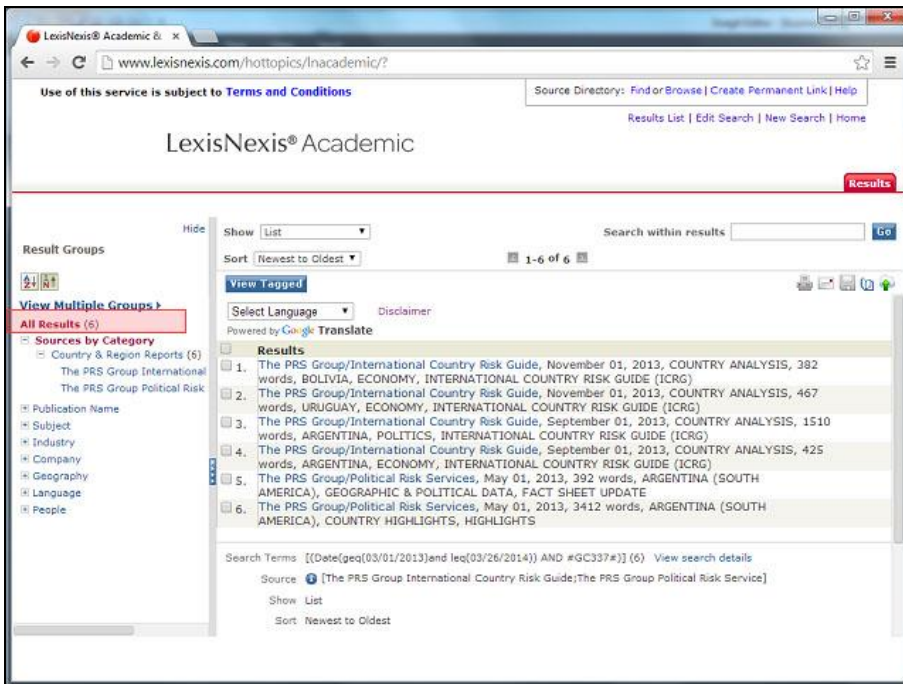
