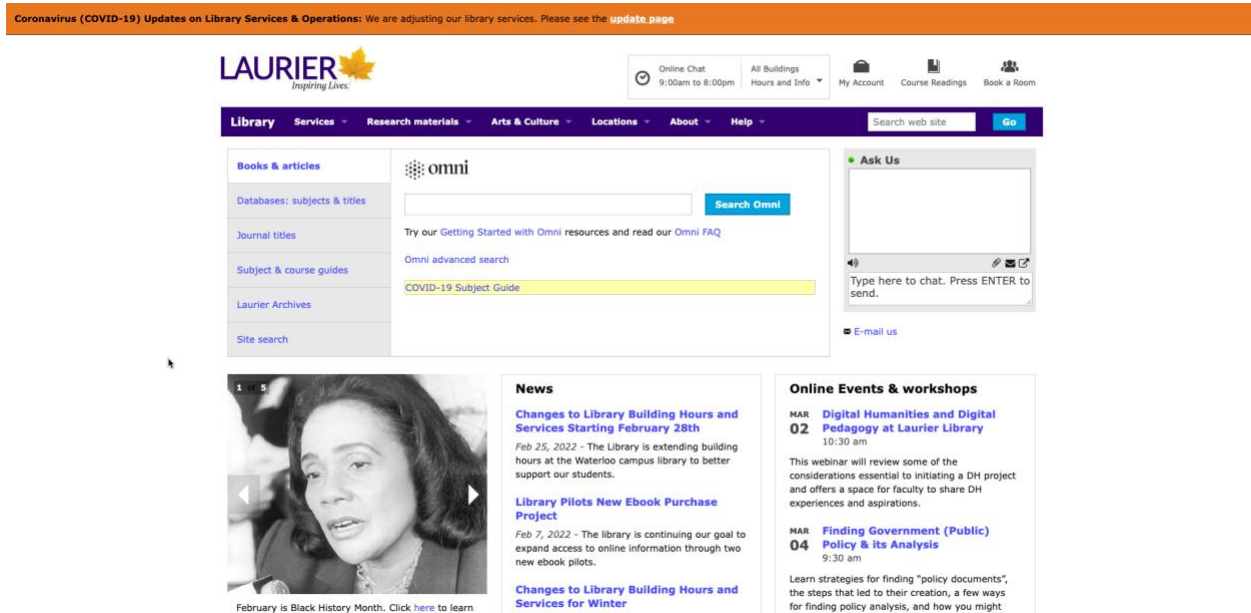
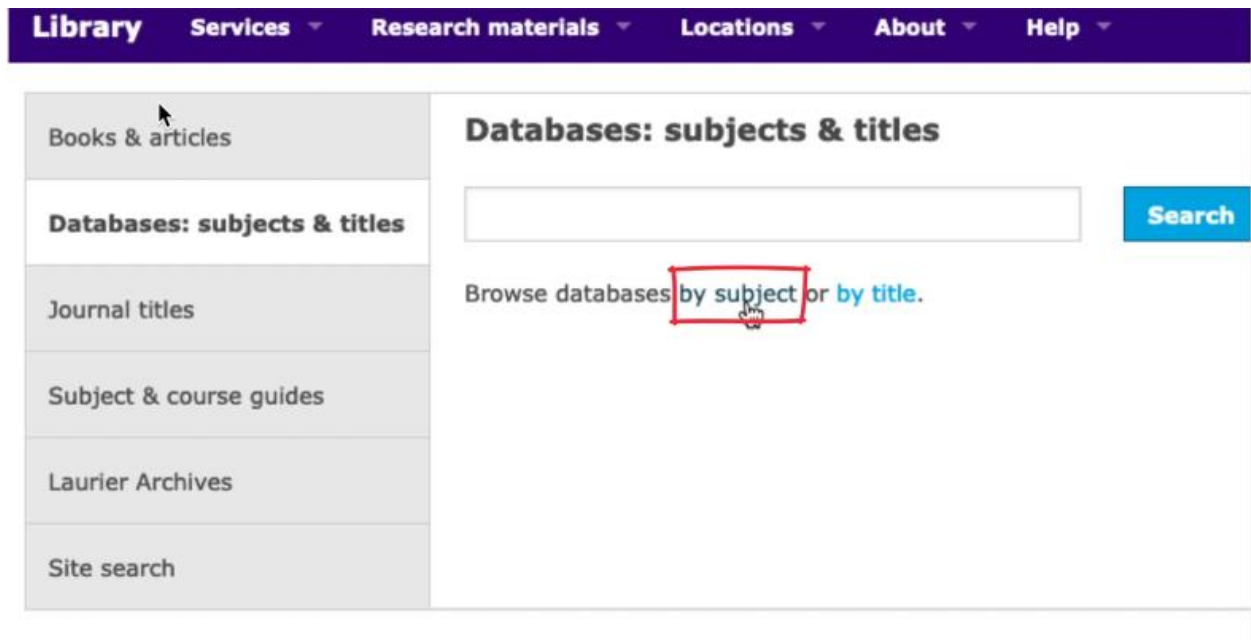


CS100 Tutorial 2 Updated Instructions

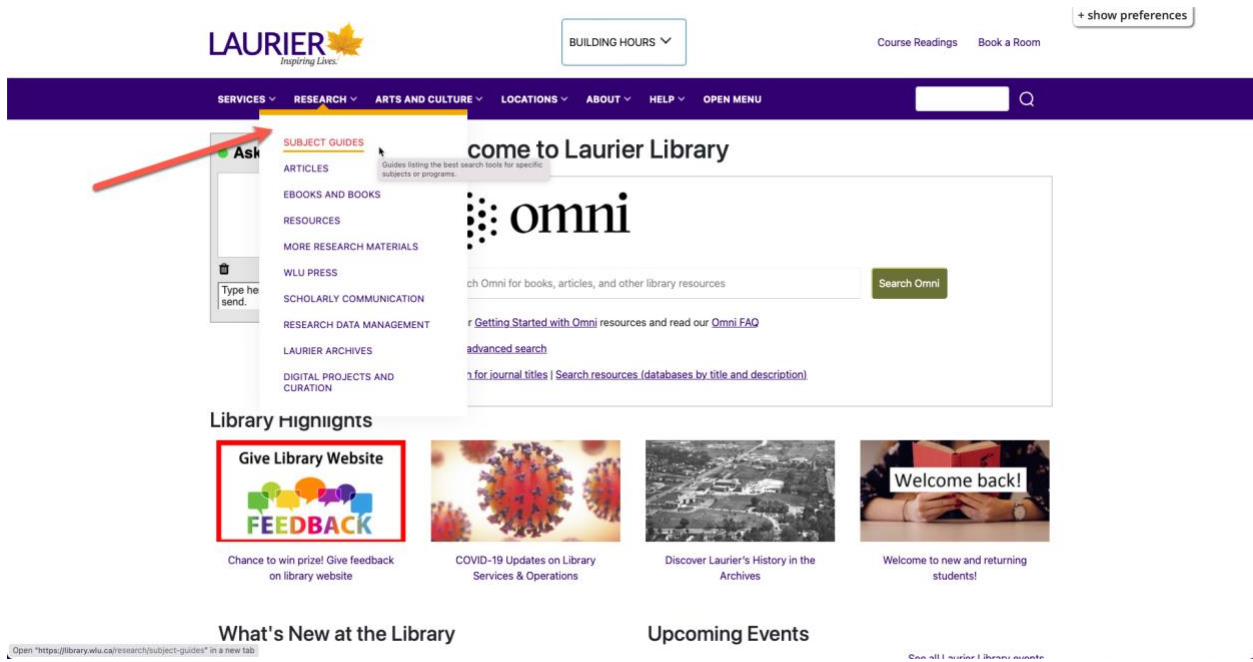
The video shows the old website homepage, which was updated at the end of August, 2022, as shown below.



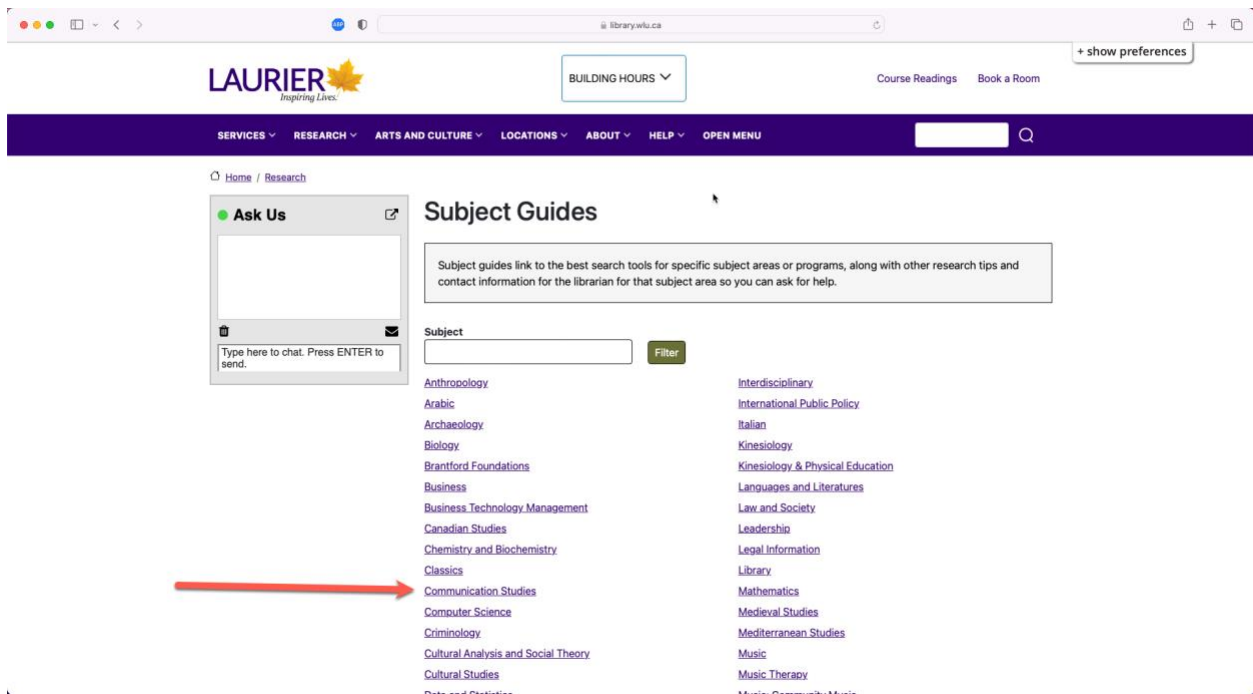
At 1:40, you are directed to use one of our specialized library databases by clicking the Databases menu option, then browse database by subject, as shown in the graphics below.
