

Finding Music Scores in Omni

To find scores, enter your keywords in the Omni search box. Keywords might be composer, title, subject, instrument, form (sonatas, songs, etc), opus number, etc.

Next, limit your results to scores. To do this, locate Resource Type in the left column of your search results page.

If you see Scores as an option under Resource Type, click on it. If not, click on Show More. Click on Scores, then on Apply Filters.

Check for the location of the score you want.

Some scores are online, and you can click on the record to locate a copy.

Some are in print. The record will give you the university, campus, location, and call number of the score so you can find it on the shelf. Print scores are located on the 4th floor of the Waterloo Library, either on the shelves near Albert St. or in the Ensemble Collection.

Your score might be part of a collection. Some collected editions will appear in your search, but not all of them. To see if your score is part of a collection, check [Oxford Music Online](#) or [WorldCat](#).
